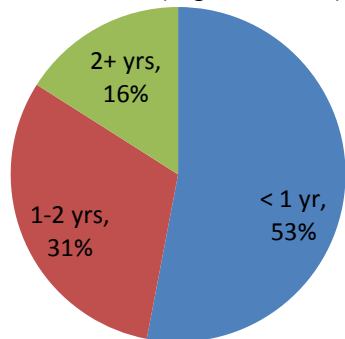

LOS Distribution (eligible families)

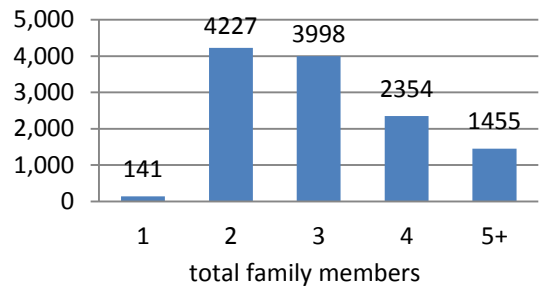

Key Changes from Last Report
