## How to Register for NYC Public Schools



Already in school and have your seat for next year?

Yes?  
You're all set.

No? We're here to help you register!

### Register for Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K)

Your student born in 2013 can start pre-K.

- Request a call from the Pre-K Outreach Team at [maps.nyc.gov/prek](https://maps.nyc.gov/prek) or call 212-637-8000.

**3-K NOTE:** District 7 (South Bronx) and District 23 (Brownsville) now offer free, full-day programs for students born in 2014. Learn more at [nyc.gov/3K](https://nyc.gov/3K).

### Register for Elementary School

Your student born in 2012 can start kindergarten. Your student born in 2011 can start first grade.

- Find your zoned school at [schools.nyc.gov/SchoolSearch](https://schools.nyc.gov/SchoolSearch) or call 311.
- To attend your zoned school, contact your zoned school directly starting **September 7**.
- If you don't have a zoned school, visit a Family Welcome Center. From **August 30 to September 15**, you can also visit a Registration Site.

### Register for Middle School

Your student who has finished fifth grade can start middle school.

- Find your zoned school at [schools.nyc.gov/SchoolSearch](https://schools.nyc.gov/SchoolSearch) or call 311.
- To attend your zoned school, contact your zoned school directly starting **September 7**.
- If you don't have a zoned school or would like to consider other options, visit a Family Welcome Center. From **August 30 to September 15** you can also visit a Registration Site.

### Register for High School

Your student who has finished eighth grade can start high school.

- Visit a Family Welcome Center year round.
- Visit a Registration Site from **August 30 to September 15**.

## What to Bring to Register

- Your student
- Proof of age: One official document that includes your student's date of birth or age. Examples: Birth certificate, passport, record of baptism
- Your student's immunization records (if available)
- Your student's latest report card/transcript (if available)
- Proof of address: Two documents that include your current home address. For a full list of accepted documents, see [schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents](https://schools.nyc.gov/NewStudents). Examples: Lease agreement, deed, or mortgage statement; gas or electric bill; cable bill; last year's income tax form; official NYS driver's license (not expired); pay stub issued within the past 60 days
- Your student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) and/or 504 Accommodation Plan (if applicable and available)

Where to Register

Please note: Families in temporary housing are not required to bring documentation in order to enroll. Schools will work to obtain the necessary documents after registration.

**From August 30-September 15 at a Registration Site**  
Monday-Friday 8am-3pm

**NOTE:** If your student is entering kindergarten through 8th grade, you can go directly to your zoned school to register starting *September 7*.
