STREET OUTREACH

Program Overview:

The Street Outreach program serves as a point of entry into the wider DYCD RHY system. Through developing rapport with youth in the streets and elsewhere, Street Outreach teams directly inform youth (runaway, homeless, and/or youth at risk of homelessness) about the available RHY services. Additionally, Street Outreach teams provide food, clothing, and other resources, makes referrals to other service providers, and transports youth back to their homes, relatives, crisis shelters, or to other safe locations.

Drop-In Centers serve youth under the age of 24 with daily essentials such as food, clothing, and immediate temporary shelter. Youth are also provided with access to counseling, support, and referrals to additional services. Drop-In centers are located in each of New York City's five boroughs.

CRISIS SHELTERS

Program Overview:

As part of the contracted portfolio of services for runaway and homeless youth, crisis shelters provide emergency shelter and crisis intervention services with the goal of reuniting youth with their families. In cases where family reunification is not possible, crisis staff collaborate with youth to locate appropriate transitional and long-term placements. Youth are housed short-term for up to 30 days with the possibility to extend for an additional 30 days.

Days and Hours of Operation:

7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

Runaway and homeless youth who are 21 years of age or younger.

SAFE HARBOUR

Program Overview

In 2008, the New York State Safe Harbour for Exploited Children Act was signed into law. Through this act, the Family Court can offer protection to youth who have been sexually exploited as well as services to address their specific social and emotional needs.

New York City currently provides a variety of services spanning several city agencies targeted at preventing sexual exploitation of children and providing services to victims and survivors of sexual exploitation.

TRANSITIONAL INDEPENDENT LIVING

Program Overview:

Transitional Independent Living (TIL) are longer-term residential facilities that provide youth between the ages of 16 and 21 with support and shelter as they work to establish an independent life. Youth may stay in the Transitional Independent Living for up to 18 months. Youth in need of longer-residential services are typically referred from Crisis Shelters.

7 days a week, 24 hours per day
