Padlet #2A: Asking Why? Why might students experiencing homelessness experience a higher rate of discipline referrals?

instability

Cannot get to school on time

daily uncertainty

difficulty getting to school on time or being tired in school

Students might have more behavioral issues because they are tired and/or hungry - basic needs are not being met consistently. Reactions to trauma - fight or flight

due to the trauma they are experiencing

Transition at EOY raises stress for students and families that rely on school daily consistency (food/shelter/access to supports etc.)

Are the students meeting for restorative conferences following behavioral incidences to determine what happened and the why? What is happening to ensure that students feel safe in school and a sense of stability and structure?
